### Supporting statement

My name is Ross Morrison and I am seeking re-election to the Scottish Fencing board having initially joined the board in 2017.

During my tenure I have been the director for Safeguarding and Welfare (May 2017 to present) and Development director (May 2017 until January 2019).

I have overseen SF reaching 100% compliance with Children First's safe guarding standards and have worked closely with Children First to establish an excellent working relationship.

I was a member of the strategy group that developed the current Scottish Fencing strategy and am currently a member of the Performance group looking towards the various Commonwealth Championships in 2022.

During my stint as Development director I helped fix and complete pay outs on the development investment scheme previously in place.
